PARTICIPATE TO A RED TENT



Festival participants have the opportunity to participate to a **Red Tent**. A Red Tent is a space dedicated to women.

The concept comes from a novel written by american author Anita Diamant. According to Valérie Dupin, co-founder of Doulas de France, the Red Tent symbolizes a place where women meet once a month when they have they menstrues and take care for each other. This story is a fiction but the description is based on various traditions of women circles or gynaecea, like Moon Lodges. The confidentality of their sharing is ensured.

The small group of women (a maximum of 8) listens and shares personal experience on turn.

Most of the RED TENTS proposed in France are held by Doulas de France.



THE ADVENTURE OF THE FESTIVAL

ontemporary women thirst for sense and freedom. They long for a sweet harmony of Yin-Yang, dancing with polarities and participating to the re-enchantment of the world. They are questioning what a woman is and what her place in society is. They are looking for the access to their feminity and pleasure, their creativity and blooming of the self. They still face all kinds of taboos. Since March 2012, through the development of its epiphenomena, the adventure of the Festival du féminin is bringing them answers and matching to their true aspirations while creating a web of friendship, encounters and experience.

In order to allow women participants to access their deeper being with no stakes, the event is wholly dedicated to women. A 2 or 3 day schedule is designed to facilitate a transformative and empowering journey. Workshops led by experienced women presenters invite participants to venture various explorations involving body sensations, sensoriality, vulnerability, as well as ankering, integration, power and chaordic harmony.

How the Festival is born

The Festival du Féminin is born in Paris. It was created on the initiative of the team of Centre Tao Paris⁽¹⁾, a contemporary dojo dedicated to « body ecology », martial arts, and transformative activities.

The first edition was held in March 2012. Deeply touched and moved by the enthousiasm raised by the first edition, the team has launched the concept

of Festival « epiphenomenon » A Charter of commitments was created to preserve the soul of the Festival and its « magic recipe ».

The name has been registered as a trademark with INPI to be protected. From this moment on, the team of co-founders have committed themselves to support the organizers of Epiphenomena and give them access to their recognized expertise and bring their communication network. Agnès Delpech⁽²⁾ who lives in Dordogne (southwest of France), is the first woman who embraced the adventure. A short time later, the Festival crossed the Atlantic to reach the land of Quebec, thanks to Sylvie Bérubé, Nathalie Picard and l'École Internationale du Féminin Sacré⁽³⁾. In this same way, many other Festivals epiphenomena are born and blossoming in the world. All nourrished by a same spontaneity, sensitive heartfelt urge full of generosity and commitment.

Caring keepers and co-ordinators of the Festival du féminin, the team of co-founders, supported by all the organizers of Epiphenomenon, facilitate the radiance of the Festival du féminin, in order to promote, accompany and transmit to future generations the diversity and the riches of the feminine.
